Mr. Chetan Bhagat is an Author, Screen Writer, Columnist & Motivational Speaker. After his studies, Mr. Bhagat worked for Goldman Sachs in their Hong Kong office as an investment banker for nearly a decade and wrote one of his most popular books "Five Point Someone" while in Hong Kong. Then, wanting to focus full-time on his writing career, he moved to Mumbai and subsequently quit his career in Investment Banking in the year 2009. He is the author of seven novels: Five Point Someone, One Night @ the Call Center, The 3 Mistakes of My Life, 2 States, Revolution 2020, Half Girlfriend, One Indian Girl and two non-fiction titles : What Young India Wants and Making India Awesome. All the books have remained bestsellers since their release and five of his books have inspired Bollywood films like Kai Po Che!, 2 States, 3 idiots, Half Girlfriend and Hello.
