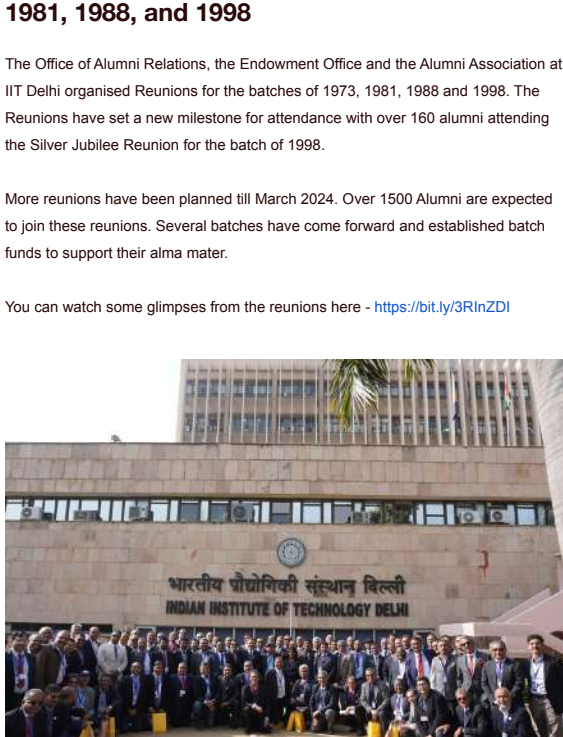

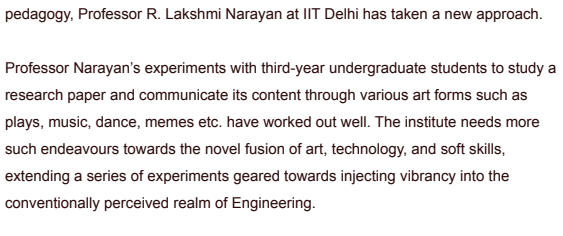
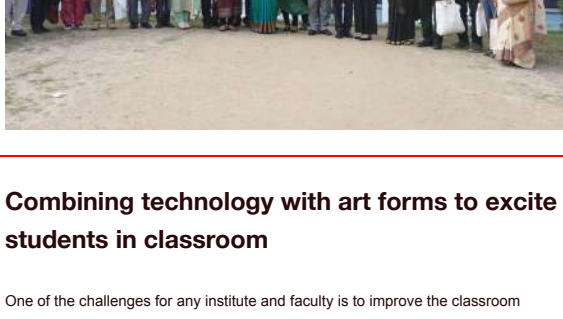


Reunions organised for the batches of 1973, 1981, 1988, and 1998

More reunions have been planned till March 2024. Over 1500 Alumni are expected to join these reunions. Several batches have come forward and established batch funds to support their alma mater.

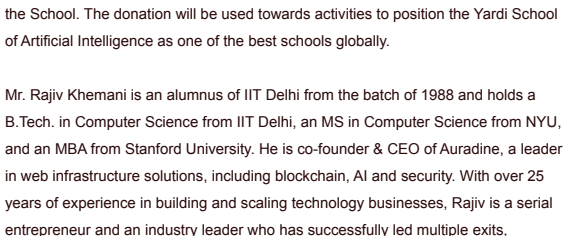

Combining technology with art forms to excite students in classroom

One of the challenges for any institute and faculty is to improve the classroom experience for students by bringing experiential learning. In the quest for innovative pedagogy, Professor R. Lakshmi Narayan at IIT Delhi has taken a new approach.

Professor Narayan's experiments with third-year undergraduate students to study a research paper and communicate its content through various art forms such as plays, music, dance, memes etc. have worked out well. The institute needs more such endeavours towards the novel fusion of art, technology, and soft skills, extending a series of experiments geared towards injecting vibrancy into the conventionally perceived realm of Engineering.

32 High School Girls completed STEM Mentorship Program

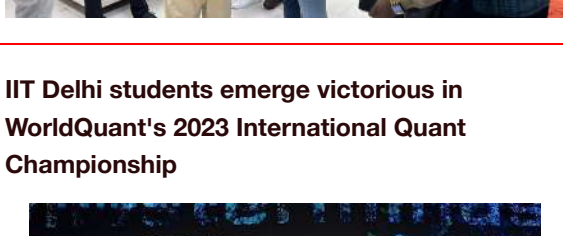
The STEM Mentorship Program's second cohort, initiated by IIT Delhi in February 2023, witnessed the successful completion by 32 high school girls. In the initial stage, chosen students from schools in Delhi-NCR were exposed to diverse research facilities at IIT Delhi. The subsequent phase featured a STEM workshop, during which participants received expert insights from IIT Delhi faculty members and research scholars representing various academic units, shedding light on emerging areas of study.
