IIT Delhi alum Mr. Khosla answered multiple questions pertaining to his work, his life at IIT, his professional journey and more importantly his vision for the future. Attendees, which consisted of students, faculty and alumni were immensely benefitted by this much awaited interaction.



New Collaborations with the Government

Aiming to leverage technology for rural development, the institute has joined hands with the Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD) through an MoU. The partnership aims to spearhead research and development initiatives in AI and geospatial technology, with a focus on enhancing the operational efficiency and transparency of projects under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA).

Ministry of Tribal Affairs has signed an MoU with IIT Delhi for promoting the socio-economic development of tribal communities in India, with a focus on empowering tribal youth through entrepreneurship and preserving indigenous practices through technology and innovation. The ministry has offered a chair professorship to be set up at IIT Delhi for this purpose.



The Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) of India marked a significant milestone by signing an MoU with IIT Delhi that underscores the commitment towards advancing audit practices through AI. Under the MoU, CAG will benefit from access to cutting-edge AI expertise, workforce capacity building, and the development of bespoke AI solutions tailored to specific audit needs.

The National Industrial Corridor Development Corporation Limited (NICDC) and IIT Delhi signed an MoU with the objective to evaluate optimality of locations for development of greenfield industrial smart cities in India leveraging the principles and framework of PM GatiShakti.

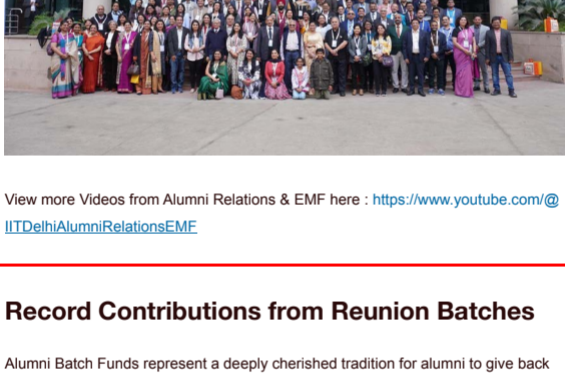

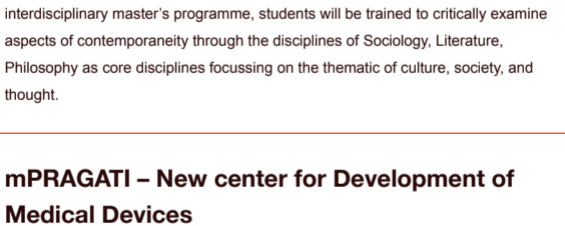
Record Contributions from Reunion Batches

mPRAGATI is a new national centre sponsored by Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) and Department of Health Research (DHR) for development of medical devices and technology. The new center is equipped with the state-of-the-art manufacturing, testing and characterization facilities as per ISO 13485 and ISO 17025 making it one stop shop for development of medical devices and translation of medical devices from proof of concept to commercial products.
