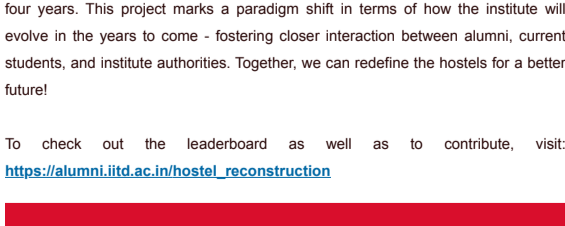
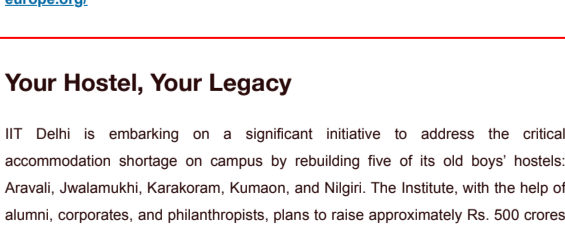
IIT Delhi students Excel at National Crossword Expedition

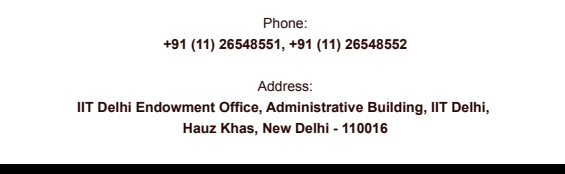
Bangalore City Meet
